Year 11 Leaving Arrangements

We are writing to make you aware of arrangements for your son/daughter as they near to the end their time at Gateacre School. Please make yourself familiar with the following important dates and times and the arrangements that go with them. Also included are some points about expectations until the end of their time here.

Friday 16th June

The official date for leaving is Friday 16th June 2017. **However, students are not expected to attend school after they have sat their very last exam,** so the actual school leaving date for your son/daughter will be when they have completed their very last paper.

On the morning of Friday 16th June, there will be a Leavers' Assembly to recognise the time your child has spent with us and the dedication they have shown over the past 5 years. Like us, you may be thinking to yourself "Where has the time gone?" During this celebration, your child will be permitted to sign each other's Leavers' Book/Shirt. Any signing of shirts prior to this date will lead to your child being asked to go home and return with a clean shirt.

Expectations

- Uniform (footwear) We appreciate that school shoes can be expensive but would
 ask that students are still wearing shoes until the end of the exam. Trainers
 are not to be worn. When students are sitting an exam they must be in full school
 uniform
- Any unwanted uniform can be donated to the school office for students who may need this help in the future, and this is very much appreciated.
- Standards The vast majority of our Y11 students have been working hard in
 preparation for their exams and we fully expect them to continue doing so. It is
 worth pointing out to all, that we still expect our high standards of attitude and
 behaviour in these final days. Any student who does not adhere to our expectations,
 will not only receive sanctions as normal, but may put their Prom place in jeopardy
